

2018 CONNECTICUT KITCHEN EQUIPMENT REBATE FOR COMMERCIAL & INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS

Valid for commercial & industrial customers ("Customer") of The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy and Yankee Gas Services Company each dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource"), United Illuminating ("UI"), the Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation ("CNG"), The Southern Connecticut Gas Company ("SCG") ("Participating Utilities") who purchase and install ENERGY STAR® rated kitchen equipment ("Equipment") on or after January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018. **REBATES WILL ONLY BE PAID TO ACCOUNT HOLDER/CUSTOMERS. All rebate applications ("Application") and required documentation must be received no later than March 31, 2019.** Rebate cannot exceed 50% of the total Equipment cost. **Pre-approval from your Participating Utility will be required if the rebate total is greater than \$5,000.** Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for a rebate incentive. Applicant understands that all funding for rebates under this program derives from the Energy Efficiency Fund which is managed, in part, by Participating Utilities and funded, in part, by their customers. Neither Participating Utility guarantees the availability of funding for this program and neither is responsible for any costs or damages incurred by applicant if funding for this program or the Energy Efficiency Fund is reduced or eliminated by the State of Connecticut, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, Department of Energy and Environmental Protection or other State of Connecticut action.

Rebates are subject to funding availability and are subject to change at any time without notice.

REBATE OFFER: The rebate is for qualifying commercial kitchen equipment ("Equipment") purchased and installed on or after January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018. Rebate levels are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. **This application form ("Application") with required documentation must be received no later than March 31, 2019.** Completed and signed Application or a letter of intent must be submitted within 30 days of the Equipment installation to be eligible for rebates.

MAXIMUM PAYMENT: The Utilities reserve the right to cap incentive amounts. Contact your Participating Utility representative or the appropriate utility company's program administrator for details.

ELIGIBILITY: Rebates are available to industrial, commercial, and institutional customers of Yankee Gas Services Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource"), United Illuminating ("UI"), the Connecticut Natural Gas Corporation ("CNG"), The Southern Connecticut Gas Company ("SCG") which are on firm gas rates. Rebates are available to industrial and commercial electric service customers with a commercial rate code on their electric service. Equipment must be installed in the service territory of the Participating Utility. Eligible systems are ENERGY STAR® approved Equipment that meets the cooking efficiency requirements.

PROOF OF PURCHASE: An installation invoice itemizing the purchased Equipment must accompany rebate Application and **must indicate the date of purchase, cost, Equipment type, size, make and model of the system(s).**

APPLICATION FORM: This Application must be filled out completely, truthfully, and accurately. The customer or its authorized representative must sign, date, and submit this Application along with the installation invoice (as outlined under Proof of Purchase), the specification sheet (indicating the qualified efficiency) and an IRS Form W9.

PAYMENT: Please allow at least 30 days for payment. Payment process may take longer if information is missing on Application. **REBATES WILL ONLY BE PAID TO ACCOUNT HOLDER/CUSTOMERS.**

APPROVAL AND VERIFICATION: Pre-approval from your Participating Utility will be required if the rebate total is greater than \$5,000. Your Participating Utility reserves the right to verify sales transactions and to have reasonable access to your facility to inspect the Equipment installed prior to or after issuing rebates.

ENDORSEMENT: Your Participating Utility does not endorse any particular manufacturer, contractor, product, or system design in promoting this initiative.

TAX LIABILITY: Your Participating Utility is not responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the customer or contractor as a result of the payment of rebates. All customers must include their Federal Tax Identification Number or Social Security Number (IRS Form W9) as part of this Application to receive a rebate.

WARRANTIES: YOUR PARTICIPATING UTILITY DOES NOT WARRANT THE PERFORMANCE OF INSTALLED EQUIPMENT, EXPRESSLY OR IMPLICITLY.

The Participating Utility makes no warranties or representation of any kind, whether statutory, expressed or implied, including, without limitations, warranties of merchantability, or fitness for particular purpose regarding Equipment or services provided by a manufacturer or vendor. Contact your contractor or Equipment manufacturer regarding Equipment performance and warranties. The Utilities do not warranty the performance of the energy efficiency measures, and do not guarantee that the listed measures will result in energy and/or cost savings.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY: Your Participating Utility's liability is limited to paying the rebate incentive specified. Participating Utilities are not liable for any damages arising

out of or resulting from participation in this rebate offer, including but not limited to loss of profits, loss of revenues, failure to realize expected savings, loss of data, loss of business opportunity, or similar losses of any kind, as well as any indirect, incidental, punitive, special, or consequential damages, or for any damages in tort connected with or resulting from participation in this Program.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: The Participating Utility reserves the right to modify payment options and restrict the amount of the rebate available for facilities using self-generation for non-emergency purposes.

CUSTOMER'S CERTIFICATION: Customer certifies that he/she has purchased and installed the Equipment listed at the Service Address indicated on this Application. Customer agrees that all information on this Application is true and conforms to all Equipment eligibility requirements and these Terms and Conditions. Customer has verified that this Equipment has been installed correctly. There are no unusual noises or vibrations and all controls have been calibrated. Customer or customer's representative has been instructed on how to operate and maintain this Equipment and has received all the necessary operation and maintenance manuals.

CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION: Contractor certifies that he/she installed the Equipment listed at the Service Address. Contractor has installed the listed Equipment in accordance with all federal, state, and local guidelines. Contractor certifies that all Contractor Information listed is true and conforms to all Equipment eligibility requirements and these Terms and Conditions. Contractor has verified that the Equipment has been installed correctly and that there are no unusual noises or vibrations and that all controls have been properly calibrated. Contractor has instructed Customer or Customer's representative on how to operate and maintain the Equipment.

FORWARD CAPACITY MARKET AND CLASS III CREDITS:

ISO-NE CAPACITY PAYMENTS: By signing this document, and as a condition to receiving a rebate pursuant to this program, the customer acknowledges and agrees that any and all payments, benefits and/or credits associated with or applicable to the customer's participation in the program that is the subject of this Agreement in connection with the ISO New England, Inc. Forward Capacity Market ("FCM") or any existing, successor or replacement markets, (including, but not limited to, any and all transitional FCM credits or payments or any and all other capacity-related credits, payments and/or benefits for which such customer is eligible) shall be deemed as and form capacity payments, credits and/or benefits of The Connecticut Light and Power Company, doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource), or The United Illuminating Company (UI), as applicable. The customer hereby assigns to Eversource or UI, as applicable, all of its right, title and interest in and to any and all such capacity payments, credits and/or benefits, and agrees to take any and all action, including executing and delivering any and all documentation and/or instruments, as requested by Eversource or UI, as applicable, to evidence the same. FCM means the market for procuring capacity pursuant to ISO-NE Tariff, FERC Electric Tariff No. 3, Section III, Market Rule 1, Section 13, any modifications to the FCM, or any successor or replacement market/capacity procurement process.

CLASS III CONSERVATION CREDITS: Any Class III renewable energy credits and/or conservation credits received in connection with this program shall be retained by the Companies pursuant to the laws of the State of Connecticut and/or applicable PURA decision in effect as of the date hereof.
