Energize Connecticut[™] Earns 2024 ENERGY STAR[®] Partner of the Year Sustained Excellence Award

Sponsors receive nationally recognized energy efficiency award for ninth time

NEW BRITAIN, Conn. – March 26, 2024 — The Sponsors of Energize ConnecticutsM, Eversource and Avangrid, Inc. subsidiaries United Illuminating, Southern Connecticut Gas and Connecticut Natural Gas, are proud to announce that they have received the 2024 ENERGY STAR[®] Partner of the Year – Sustained Excellence Award from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy. This is the ninth time the sponsors have been recognized for their joint efforts, continued leadership and commitment to providing robust energy efficiency programs for customers in Connecticut.

The 2023 award recognized Eversource and the Avangrid subsidiaries for several core programs designed to help customers save energy. Key accomplishments include:

- Providing incentives for 888 pieces of ENERGY STAR certified equipment, a 17 percent increase in unit sales from 2022.
- Foodservice programs seeing a 32 percent increase in therms savings and a 55 percent increase in pieces of equipment rebated, compared to the same time in 2022.
- The heating, cooling and water heating programs saving 860,000 kWh annually on ENERGY STAR certified equipment. This is a 166 percent increase compared to the same period in 2022.

"We're proud to equip customers with a variety of energy efficiency programs and resources that help them reduce their energy usage and lower their energy bills," said Eversource Director of Energy Efficiency Ron Araujo. "ENERGY STAR is an important partner for the Sponsors of Energize CT, as we strive to help businesses and residents in the state to make informed decisions and build a clean energy future. It's an honor to be recognized again with the Partner of the Year Award by the EPA and DOE for our collaborative efforts. We look forward to continuing our work together and mitigating the effects of climate change through the delivery of our energy efficiency programs."
